



European Restorative Justice Award

Submit your personal proposal for the 2012 Award

In celebration of its 10th anniversary, the European Forum for Restorative Justice (EFRJ) launched the "European Restorative Justice Award". It is dedicated to recognize and celebrate outstanding contributions by individuals, groups or organisations, to the development of restorative justice within Europe. Worthy of dedication can be any significant contribution, either in theoretical, practical, empirical, political or ideational respect. The award is granted biannually and handed over at a plenary session of the regular international conferences of the EFRJ. Laureates are nominated by the Board of the EFRJ upon proposals submitted by the EFRJ membership. The award is unremunerated. First Award holder (2010) is Professor Ivo Aertsen, Belgium.

You are invited to submit your personal proposal for the 2012 Award which will be handed over at the biennial conference in Helsinki, Finland. Proposals can be submitted by individual members and by one individual representing an organisational member. One person can submit one or more proposals. Proposals must consist of a name of a person or organisation, active in the restorative justice field, and a motivation of why you propose this person/organisation.
