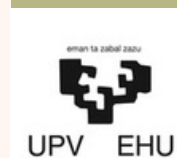

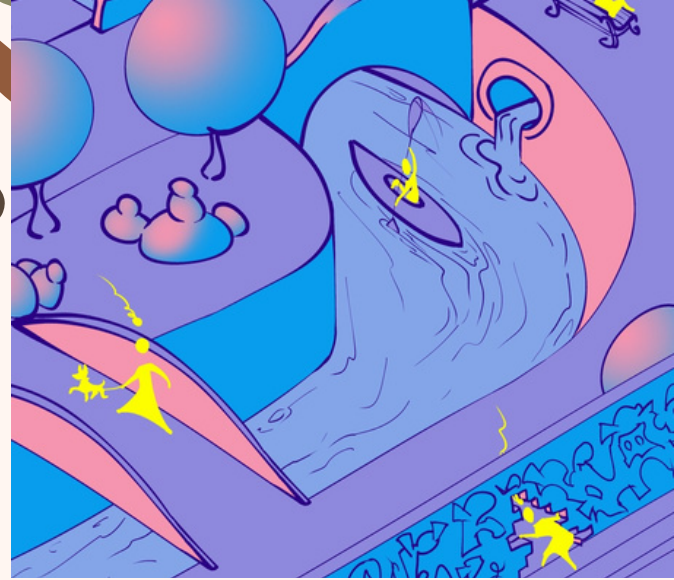

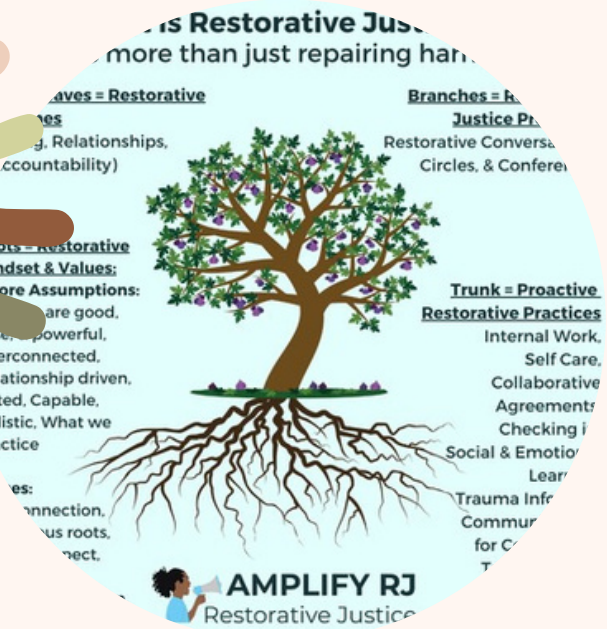
May 31, afternoon

INTRODUCTION AND DIVIDING INTO SUB-GROUPS

Five real cases have been selected in the Spanish context, but of general interest at a global level. The participants, about 30-40 people, will be distributed in five subgroups, where we will try to have people in the role of restorative justice facilitators who will dynamize the subgroups, helped by students, as well as legal operators (judges, prosecutors, police, forest rangers, lawyers), activists in the environmental and animal rights field, and researchers of restorative justice in relation to Green Criminology.

The conclusions reached in each subgroup will be discussed in order to make a general reflection on the points that should be further developed for future meetings in this field. With these conclusions, reworked, with a practical orientation, an open publication will be available in collaboration with Dykinson editorial.
